FOR NEIGHBORS OF THE JOHNSON STREET TEMPORARY EMERGENCY SHELTER

## **IF YOU ARE HAVING OR WITNESSING AN EMERGENCY OR IMMEDIATE SAFETY THREAT, CALL 911**

If you are in immediate danger, are facing an urgent threat to safety, and/or encounter someone who is an immediate danger to themselves or others, please call 911. 911 is also able to dispatch Missoula's Mobile Support Team (MST), which is a mobile unit that includes an EMT and a licensed clinical social worker. If you encounter someone and are feeling unsafe, and you think that person is experiencing a mental health crisis or a behavioral health crisis, please clearly state that to the 911 dispatcher when you report your situation; you can tell them that you think the person is in a "mental health crisis" or a "behavioral health crisis." This will alert them to the need for the Mobile Support Team.

If you live or work near the Emergency Shelter and have a non-emergency law enforcement concern about activity on your property or in your neighborhood, please send your concern to [pdwintershelter@ci.missoula.mt.us](mailto:pdwintershelter@ci.missoula.mt.us). You may also call the 24-hour non-emergency desk at 406-552- 6300. Be aware that this email is not monitored 24/7; for anything requiring immediate response, please call 911. The Homeless Outreach Team has relationships with many folks in Missoula who are unhoused and can help folks meet basic needs and make connections to resources. They may also be able to de-escalate someone as long as the person is not posing a safety threat or an immediate danger to themselves or others. HOT is not responsible for responding to urgent safety concerns.
